Roaches. To ensure the best treatment results for Roaches the residen	t must cooperate in the
preparation of their apartment for treatment.	

The resident must:

- 1. All food needs to be placed in sealed containers and place in front room or placed in the refrigerators. Including non-perishable food items that are out on countertops. Please remove all pet dishes from the unit
 - a. Remove exposed food and drinks prior to application; fruits, vegetables, etc.
 - b. Remove dishes, utensils, glasses, etc. from the area being treated.
 - c. AFTER-TREATMENT All countertops, cupboards, and all floors should be wiped down with mild soap and warm water.
- 2. All items in the bathroom should be removed from the cupboards as well as on the sink, (toothbrushes, soap, fragrances, etc)
- 3. Please empty if available medicine cabinets any personal items.
- 4. Vacate the premises when the treatment is being done and all tenants and all live animals must stay out of the premises for <u>4 HOURS</u> after treatment is completed unless otherwise specified.
 - a. All tanks fish/reptile must be covered, and pumps must turn off prior to treatment.
- 5. All open flames must be turned off. Ex. gas stove polite lights or /and hot water tanks.

Post-Treatment

1. All appliances (tv, DVD, radio, stove, refrigerator etc.) must be wiped down with mild soap and warm water, rag must be damped only, including the bathroom counter tops, and bathroom appliances (bathtub, toilet area)
